Dear Parents/Carers,

Our students have now settled into routines and are meeting our expectations after returning from the Christmas break, which now seems like a very long time ago! With just 15 days left in school this half-term, it is important for our young people to continue to attend every day and do the very best they can. Your children are a real credit to the whole community - the vast majority of our young people live out our values and demonstrate compassion, resilience and maturity on a daily basis; you should be proud of them!

Next week, we have a guest motivational speaker in College - an ex Royal Marine, Scotty Mills. Scotty has worked with many high profile individuals and teams (nationally and internationally) to build character, resilience and teamwork. As we all know, poor attendance is the single biggest contributing factor effecting poor progress and attainment for our young people; we need to keep a sharp focus on this area to ensure all students are able to fulfil their potential. Finally, our parental engagement for Parents' Evenings (both remote and face-to-face) is not as strong as it could be. I fully appreciate that there are some barriers for some people with work commitments and so on, but may I impress on you the importance of these events in terms of you gaining invaluable insights into the progress your children are making, and in giving you the opportunity to voice concerns or speak to key staff directly.
