The senior invigilator reported how well they had all behaved in the mocks; their good manners and engagement has been noted by external speakers/ revision providers; we have also been very pleased with how responsible they have been in turning up on time for intervention and exam support sessions, as well as the excellent attendance at after school revision classes. As we approach the examination season, there is quite a lot of significant information to share with you. I have tried to collate much of this in this letter to avoid you receiving multiple messages. I hope that you find the information and supportive opportunities helpful, and, as a result, will feel more confident in supporting your child at this crucial time.

#### **Core Subject Revision Evening**

Firstly, I would like to remind you about the Core Subject Revision Evening taking place from 5.30pm, on Tuesday 20th February (the week after the half term break), in the auditorium. The event is for parents/carers of Year 11 *and* their child/ren.

In the past, this has proved to be an extremely popular and helpful event for parents and students.
