Christ the King College Celebrates Superb A Level & BTEC Results

Christ the King College is proud to celebrate the achievements of its Sixth Form students as they receive their A Level and Applied General results today.

This year, 70% of A Level grades were awarded at A*–C, maintaining the excellent standard achieved in 2024. Students studying BTEC qualifications were rewarded with particularly exceptional results; 73% attaining the top grades of Distinction–Distinction and an outstanding 100% pass rate across these programmes. Student progress also continues to be a strength with some students achieving two grades above their target data.

Some particularly impressive outcomes were seen in Physics where 60% of grades awarded were A*-A. Mathematics candidates achieved an impressive 57.1% at the same high standard (A*-A). Students in Classics, Fine Art, and Physics secured 100% A*-C grades. In Applied General qualifications, every student in Health and Social Care attained top marks, with 100% achieving Distinction*–Distinction.

Christ the King Sixth Form students will now progress to a wide range of exciting next steps, including higher education, apprenticeships, and employment. 83% of University applicants achieved a place at one of their chosen Universities. 40% of these to Russell Group Universities. 33% of students are moving in alternative directions, for example, two students have been recruited to Camp America, one into the Navy, several with apprenticeships in a range of professions from nursing, to engineering, to travel.
