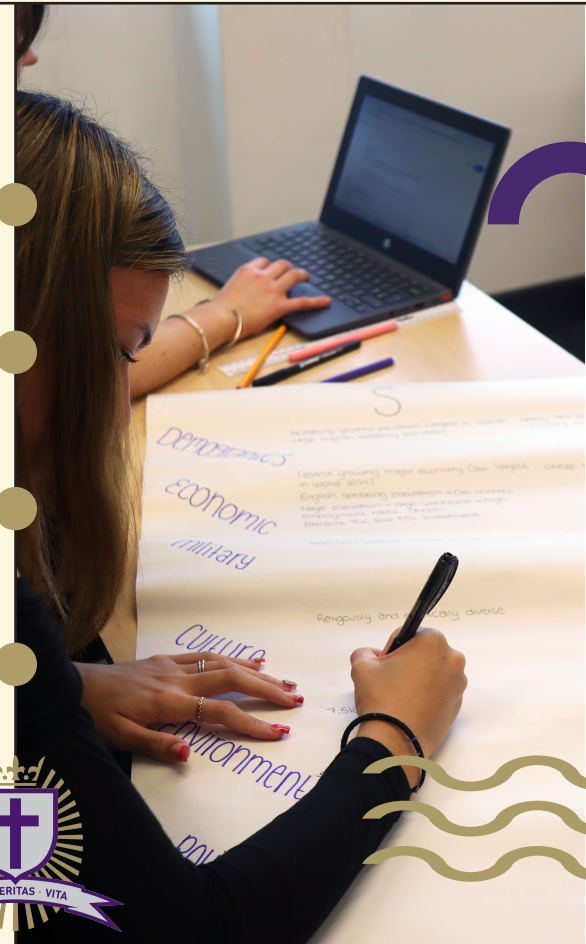


- Geography is a highly valued subject by universities, it can be a facilitating subject - that is a subject most likely to be required or preferred for entry to degree courses.

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
