Course Structure



Coursework

which contributes 60% of the total mark. This comprises of a practical portfolio which explores and develops a selected theme and a linked written personal study of a minimum of 1000 words of continuous prose.



Externally Set Assignment

which contributes 40% of the total mark. A theme is set each year by the Exam board in February and students develop this project culminating in a 15 hour practical exam where final outcomes are created.
