

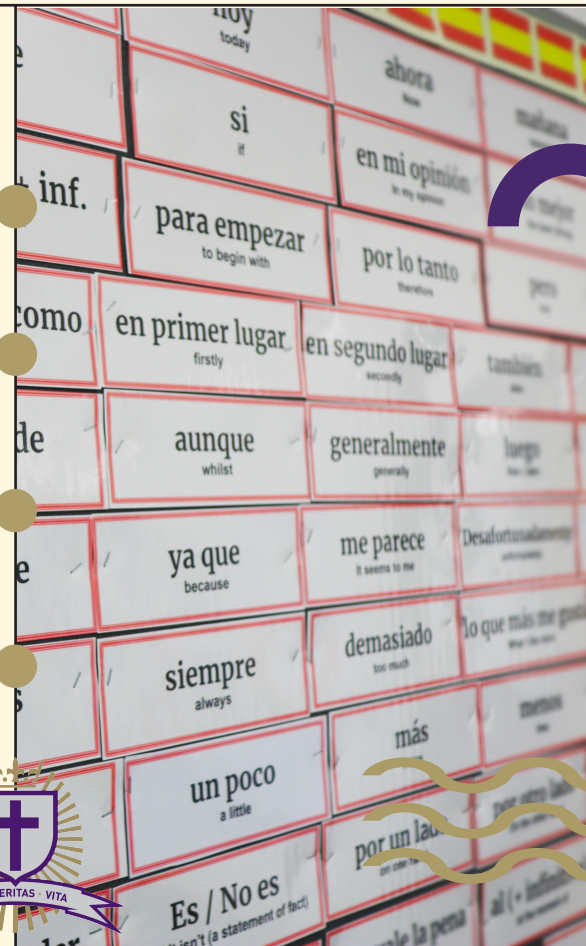
Why you should study...

Studying A-Level Spanish can offer a wide range of benefits, both academically and personally. As the second-most spoken native language worldwide, being able to speak Spanish opens doors to careers in multinational companies, international organisations, and industries such as tourism, trade, and diplomacy. An ability to speak Spanish facilitates travelling to Spanish-speaking countries making the experience more immersive, enabling you to better engage with local people and giving you a better understanding of their culture. This A level Spanish course follows the AQA specification which covers such topics as technological developments and the cultural heritage of past civilisations in the context of the Spanish speaking world. Students will learn about Hispanic artistic culture as well as Spanish regional identity and will explore topics which will help them better understand culture and society in countries where Spanish is spoken. In addition to this, students will study a text or a film.


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Those considering this course should have a Grade 5-6 or above in Spanish GCSE, as well as a Grade 4 or above in English GCSE.
